Oklahoma Equestrian Trail Riders Association, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization formed in 1974 for the purpose of promoting trail riding. OETRA's code stresses courtesy to fellow trail riders, safety and care of the horse on the trail. **Did you realize OETRA has recently donated from membership dues and fund raisers, more than \$12,000 to make improvements at horse trails across Oklahoma?** OETRA has installed horse corrals and other camp improvements at Robbers Cave State Park, maintains the trails and hosts work weeks each year. OETRA has donated funds to Heyburn Lake, Kaw Lake, Sportsman Lake; and hosts a work week each year at Cedar Lake. Your membership dollars help support our horse trails system. OETRA is also a watchdog on any legislation that affects our Oklahoma horse trails.

OETRA offers:

- Organized trail rides at equestrian campgrounds throughout the state - Mary Ben Marshall Spring Ride, Bell Cow Lake, Chandler, OK (held in April); National Trails Day (First Saturday of June) Robbers Cave State Park, Wilburton, OK; Labor Day Ride (Labor Day weekend); Robbers Cave State Park, Wilburton, OK; Horsecamping 101 Clinic, (October), and Fall Color Ride (first weekend in November), Cedar Lake Equestrian Camp, Heavener, OK. Meetings are held at OETRA-sponsored trail rides.
- *THE TRAILRIDER* monthly newsletter features a complete listing of all rides, local and regional news, reports of upcoming rides and events, reviews by other trail riders of places they have ridden. Newsletter is available in full color format online via email or a black and white version can be mailed to your home.
