Attractions:

The campground is the most popular starting point for the Winding Stair Mountain Equestrian Trails, a 70-plus mile system of marked equestrian trails.*

These trails are a network of loops that wind over hills and mountains and through a variety of vegetation from tall majestic pines and stately hardwoods to rich river bottoms. The loops offer a rider the opportunity to decide the length of ride and type of experience desired.

Nearby, visitors may enjoy additional facilities at Cedar Lake Recreation Area, including campsites, picnic sites, swimming beaches and fishing piers on the scenic 86-acre lake.

Location:

Approximately 12 miles south of Heavener, Oklahoma, and 40 miles west of Mena, Arkansas. Access Recreation Area from Holson Valley Road (County Road 212) off US Highways 59/270 or US Highway 271.

Facilities:

- 44 campsites with electric and water hookups (include 4 double sites).
- 4 campsites that are accessible for people with disabilities and have water and electric hookup.
- 9 campsites with centrally located water.
- 75 primitive campsites without picnic tables, fire rings, etc. Central water available.
- 2 restrooms with flush toilets and warm showers.
- 3 horse washing facilities.
- 2 picnic shelters can be reserved
- 2 group picnic shelters, several picnic sites.
- 1 boat ramp.
- 2 fishing piers.

Note: most campsites have a picnic table, tent pad, fire-ring, lantern pole and paved parking spur.

Fees: Current fees and regulations are posted at the self-service pay station.

Season of Use: Open year-round.

Note: Current negative Coggins test required.

Several camping areas may be reserved by calling the National Reservation System at 1-877-444-6777 at least 10 days in advance. Others are first-come, first-served.

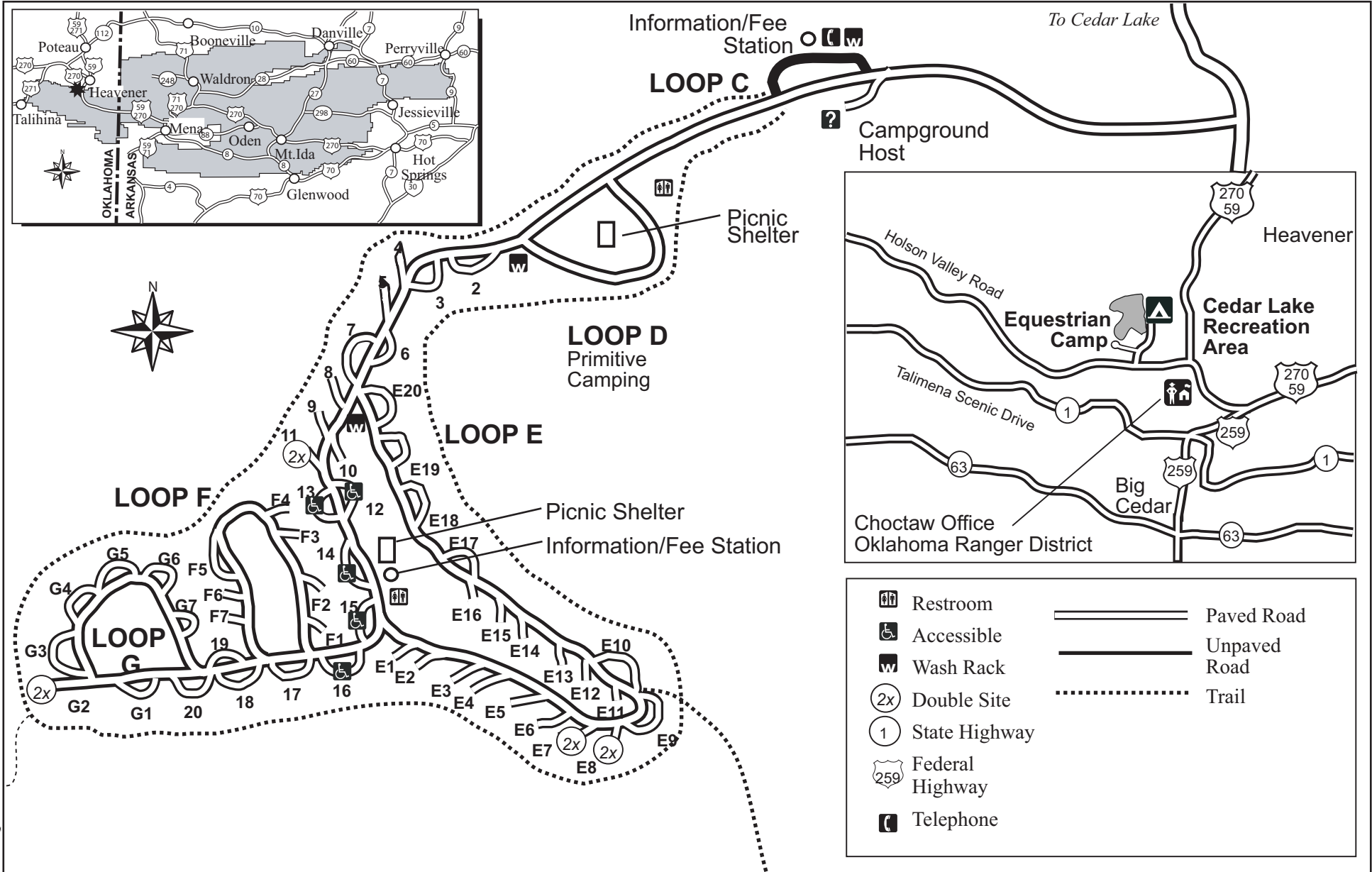
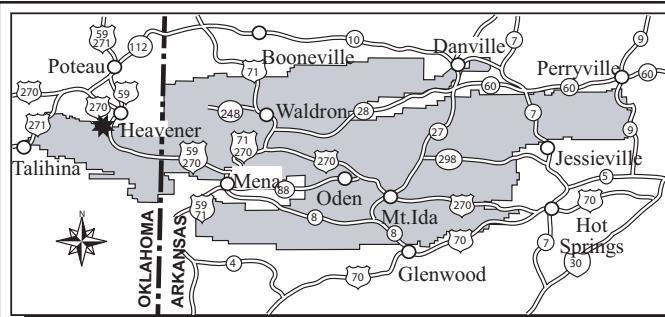
